

**Multiplying By 286:**

A. This method is derived from [Multiplying by 143](#). Since  $286 = 1001 \times (\frac{2}{7})$  you can divide by 7, multiply by 2, then [multiply by 1001](#).

Ex [1]  $77 \times 286 =$ \_\_\_\_\_.

- a)  $77 \div 7 = 11$ .
- b)  $11 \times 2 = 22$ .
- c)  $22 \times 1001 = 22022$ .
- d) The answer is 22022.

Ex [2]  $286 \times 287 =$ \_\_\_\_\_.

- a)  $287 \div 7 = 41$ .
- b)  $41 \times 2 = 82$ .
- c)  $82 \times 1001 = 82082$ .
- d) The answer is 82082.
