

Multiplying By 375:

A. Multiplying by 375 is derived from [Multiplying by 125](#). Since $375 = 1000 \times (\frac{3}{8})$ you can divide by 8, multiply by 3, and then multiply by 1000.

Ex [1] $168 \times 375 =$ _____.

- a) $168 \div 8 = 21$.
- b) $21 \times 3 = 63$.
- c) $63 \times 1000 = 63000$.
- d) The answer is 63000.

Ex [2] $424 \times 375 =$ _____.

- a) $424 \div 8 = 53$.
- b) $53 \times 3 = 159$.
- c) $53 \times 1000 = 159000$.
- d) The answer is 159000.
