

Multiplying By 429:

A. Multiplying by 429 is derived [Multiplying by 143](#). Since $429 = 1001 \times (\frac{3}{7})$ you can divide by 7, multiply by 3, and then [multiply by 1001](#).

Ex [1] $84 \times 429 =$ _____.

- a) $84 \div 7 = 12$.
- b) $12 \times 3 = 36$.
- c) $36 \times 1001 = 36036$.
- d) The answer is 36036.

Ex [2] $847 \times 429 =$ _____.

- a) $847 \div 7 = 121$.
- b) $121 \times 3 = 363$.
- c) $363 \times 1001 = 363363$.
- d) The answer 363363.
