Multiplying By 625:

- A. Multiplying by 625 is derived from <u>Multiplying by 125</u>. Since $625 = 1000 \text{ x} (\frac{5}{8})$ you can divide by 8, multiply by 5 (see section I for an easy way o f doing this), and multiply by 1000.
 - Ex [1] 64 x 625 =_____.
 - a) $64 \div 8 = 8$.
 - b) $8 \ge 5 = 40$.
 - c) $40 \ge 1000 = 40000$.
 - d) The answer is 40000.
 - Ex [2] 625 x 816 =____.
 - a) $816 \div 8 = 102$.
 - b) $102 \ge 5 = 510$.
 - c) $5100 \times 1000 = 510000$.
 - d) The answer is 510000.
