

Multiplying By 858:

A. Multiplying by 858 is derived from [Multiplying by 143](#). Since $858 = 1001 \times (\frac{6}{7})$ you can divide by 7, multiply by 6, and [multiply by 1001](#).

Ex [1] $91 \times 858 =$ _____.

- a) $91 \div 7 = 13$.
- b) $13 \times 6 = 78$.
- c) $78 \times 1001 = 78078$.
- d) The answer is 78078.

Ex [2] $847 \times 858 =$ _____.

- a) $847 \div 7 = 121$.
- b) $121 \times 6 = 726$.
- c) $726 \times 1001 = 726726$.
- d) The answer is 726726.
